

International Interprofessional Wound Care Course IIWCC-CAN 2024-2025

Dear Prospective IIWCC Student:

On behalf of our faculty and staff, we would like to thank you for your registration & welcome you to the International Interprofessional Wound Care Course (IIWCC-CAN), Class of 2024-2025!

The IIWCC- CAN is hosted by WoundPedia, a not-for-profit organization. Numerous wound care professionals have been educated and mentored internationally under the auspices of the IIWCC for over two decades. We sincerely hope that you will find this course meets your clinical & educational expectations as new knowledge transfers into your practice. Below is the key information you will need to begin your educational journey, starting with the Fall Educational Session.

This nine to twelve-month course consists of fourteen self-study modules (nine required to complete), a selective related to each student's day-to-day activities, **two mandatory** Virtual Educational Sessions to attend, **three mandatory** evening Skills Workshop Zoom meetings to attend, and 3 Skills Workshop assignments (to complete). More information will be sent via email as it becomes available. Dates for the Educational Sessions are as follows:

Virtual Fall Educational Session - September 12-14th, 2024 (3 days)
&
Virtual Spring Educational Session - June 12-14th, 2025 (3 days) *

*These dates are subject to change only in extreme circumstances In the event that the Educational Session dates do change, you will be notified by email.

*The entire weekend will be held online from the comfort of your own home. There is no need to book any flights or hotels for these educational sessions.

Ensure you have a working laptop with audio and video capabilities and internet connection. You should familiarize yourself with Zoom Meetings, as we will be using it for the entire weekend. The app can be downloaded free at: <https://zoom.us/>. Details of this will be confirmed closer to the weekend. We will have complementary IT support, so you will be fully supported prior to and during the session. Enough time will be given for everyone to log on, join meetings etc.

Please make yourselves available for participation for the entire session in both Fall 2024 and Spring 2025 sessions, as attendance is mandatory and participation to many interactive activities will be logged. You are expected to appear on camera during the entire duration of the educational sessions to ensure your attendance.

An agenda will be sent to you as soon as it is finalized. An email will be sent to everyone closer to the educational session to confirm your attendance. Watch for communications and emails between now and the educational session, especially closer to the time. These emails will come from Patrycja Fraser at iiwccmodules@gmail.com

Second Educational Session- June 12-14th, 2025

Course Materials

All required reading materials, including an electronic course handbook and other course material will be sent a few days prior to the first day of the Fall Educational Session in September 2024.

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years. Also note that the course material, including readings and questions, cannot be given to students prior to the 1st Educational Session.

Mandatory ZOOM Skills Workshop Meetings

Throughout the course, there are 3 ZOOM meetings that you will be required to attend virtually. These ZOOM meetings last 3-3.5 hours. Attendance is logged throughout the ZOOM meeting.

*If you withdraw from the course after December 31st, 2024, **you are required to pay 1/2 of the course registration fee plus a \$100 cancellation fee** (to cover materials costs and the costs incurred at the residential course weekend). HST will be adjusted.
